Instructors are encouraged to raise Starfish Flags for students in their courses. Select the Academic Flag that best describes a student's individual situation to alert the student and members of their support network to your concerns.

Tip: Raising flags will initiate outreach to the students by Academic Advisors' and Retention Coordinators.



ACADEMIC FLAG: LOW AVERAGE IN COURSE

1

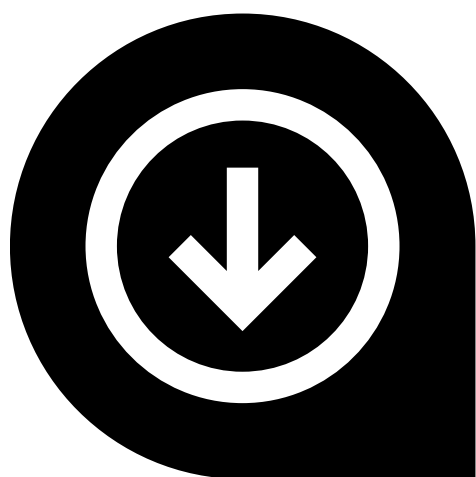
Student has multiple low scores on tests, quizzes, and assignments. Raise this flag for a student whose grade is borderline according to the academic standards for the course/program.



ACADEMIC FLAG: AT-RISK OF FAILING

2

Student's course grade or overall performance is putting them in danger of failing the course. If you raise this flag due to an attendance concern, please provide a brief note (No Show, Attendance Concern, etc.) so that flagged student can receive the appropriate supportive intervention(s).



ACADEMIC FLAG: MIDTERM BELOW 70%

3

This flag will only be available during the 11th week for students who have earned a D or F midterm grade.



ACADEMIC FLAG: MISSING/LATE ASSIGNMENTS

'Missing and/or late assignments jeopardizes student success in the course. If you raise this flag for a student, please be sure to detail your policy on make-up work. Allowing students to make up work is at full discretion of the professor.
