

Spring 2023 Refund Withdrawal Schedule

Refunds are allowed for full-time and part-time undergraduate and graduate students.
Refund percentages are based on the official start of the term.

16 Week Session

Classes Begin January 30 – May 26, 2023

100% Adjustment On/Before February 10, 2023 Tuition and Fees (fulltime/part time)

50% Adjustment On/Before February 17, 2023 Tuition only (part-time and graduate)

No financial adjustment after February 17, 2023

8 Week Session I

Classes Begin January 30 – March 17, 2023

100% Adjustment On/Before February 3, 2023 Tuition and Fees (fulltime/part-time)

50% Adjustment On/Before February 10, 2023 Tuition and Fees (part-time only)

No financial adjustment after February 10, 2023

8 Week Session II

Classes Begin March 27 - May 19, 2023

100% Adjustment On/Before March 31, 2023 Tuition and Fees (part-time only)

50% Adjustment On/Before April 7, 2023 Tuition only (part-time only)

No refunds/adjustments for courses dropped after April 7, 2023

If you choose not to attend Bowie State University, you must notify the Registrar's Office and drop by the end of the change of schedule period in order to receive 100% refund of tuition and fees. Notification to the instructor does not constitute a proper withdrawal. All refund percentages are based on the official start of the term.

Special Note to Undergraduate Fulltime students: If you are registered as a fulltime student (12 credit hours or more) and later drop to a part-time status (less than 12 credits) after the official add/drop date, you will not be entitled to refunds and/or financial adjustments based on a per credit hour charge. Charges for the term shall remain at the fulltime rate.

If you are a financial aid recipient, the Office of Financial Aid is required by federal statute to recalculate federal financial aid eligibility for students who withdraw (officially or unofficially), are dismissed, or take a leave of absence. As a result all financial aid recipients are subject to review as mandated by the U.S. Department of Education.
