Chanel L. Turner ('06)



Chanel L. Turner is undoubtedly a pioneer in the U.S. craft wine & spirit industry. Her triumphs and successes in the extremely regulated, non-diversified alcohol and wine industry are a testament to her unparalleled resilience and commitment to excellence. After earning a bachelor's degree in business management from Bowie State University, Chanel began a career in information technology but knew that entrepreneurship was her true calling.

In 2009, at 25 years old, Chanel founded FOU-DRÉ LLC. Not only is Chanel the first woman to own a vodka brand, but she is the first African American woman, as well as the youngest individual to own and operate a spirit brand. At a time of widespread racial, gender and socio-economic disparities, Chanel defied the odds to bring a patented product to market and launched FOU-DRÉ Vodka in 2012.

To date, FOU-DRÉ has won countless awards and has been featured on NBC4, WJLA's Working Woman segment, Fox 5 Cheers to the weekend, The Tom Joyner Morning Show and countless podcasts and news segments.
