Dr. Dwonna Naomi Goldstone is an associate professor of history and director of the African American Studies Program at

Texas State University. She received her B.A. in American Studies from the U of Iowa; her MAT in Secondary English Education from Brown University; and her Ph.D. in American Studies from the University of Texas at Austin. Her book, *Integrating the Forty Acres: The Fifty-Year Struggle for Racial Equality at the University of Texas,* won the Coral H. Tullis Memorial Prize for the Best Book on Texas History. Dr. Goldstone mostly writes on Black history and Black culture, and she is currently finishing an essay titled "Teaching While Black: A Black Professor in Trumpland." Dr. Goldstone lives in San Marcos, Texas, with her four dogs: Lena Horne, Ralph Ellison, Ernie Banks, and Hank Aaron.
