

TONY WYLIE JOINED BOWIE STATE IN FALL OF 2023. TONY TEAHES SPORT MARKETING AND PROMOTIONS AND BRINGS OVER 30 YEARS OF SPORT INDUSTRY EXPERIENCE. HE IS THE FOUNDER AND CEO OF THE COLLECTIVE ENGINE- A MARKETING FIRM THAT WILL SECURE THE NAME, IMAGE AND LIKENESS FOR ELITE ATHLETES, WHILE PROVIDING DIRECTION FOR FINANCIAL LITERACY, SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY AND LEADERSHIP AND CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT. TONY HAS ALSO SERVED AS REGIONAL PRESIDENT AND MANAGING DIRECTOR FOR SPECIAL OLYMPICS NORTH AMERICA, AND SENIOR VICE PRESIDENT OF COMMUNICATIONS FOR THE WASHINGTON REDSKINS AND OTHER NATIONAL FOOTBALL LEAGUE TEAMS.

TONY HELPED THE RAMS THROUGH THEIR 1995 TRANSITION FROM LOS ANGELES TO ST. LOUIS AND LEADING RELOCATION AND RENAMING OF THE TENNESSEE TITANS. HE WAS ONE OF THE FIRST HIRES OF THE EXPANSION OF THE HOUSTON TEXANS ON 2000, DEVELOPING THE NEW FRANCHISE'S IMAGE.

AS A COMMUNICATIONS EXECUTIVE, TONY WON MULTIPLE AWARDS SUCH AS THE FIVE-TIME RECIPIENT OF PRO FOOTBALL WRITERS OF AMERICA PETE ROZELLE AWARD, TEXAS SOUTHERN UNIVERSITY DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARD(2004), SPIRIT AWARD FROM THE HOUSTON ASSOCIATION OF BLACK JOURNALISTS (2010), SWAC ALUMNI ASSOCIATION LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD(2015), TSU OUTSTANDING ALUMNI AWARD(2017), BOARD OF DIRECTORS PRESIDENT AND A GLOBAL ATHLETIC FOUNDATION FOR YOUTH AWARD (2017).

ACCOMPLISHED ALUMNI

KYLE JACKSON

BOWIE STATE FOOTBALL HEAD COACH GRADUATED 2011



KYLE WILL BE ENTERING HIS THIRD SEASON AS THE HEAD COACH FOR THE BOWIE STATE UNIVERSITY FOOTBALL TEAM. KYLE IS VERY INVOLVED IN THE COMMUNITY AND THE SPORT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM AT BOWIE STATE UNIVERSITY.

IN 2021, JACKSON WAS THE RECRUITING COORDINATOR AND LINEBACKERS COACH, WHERE HE WAS AN INSTRUMENTAL PIECE IN THE BULLDOGS HISTORIC SEASON, SECURING A THIRD-CONSECUTIVE CIAA CONFERENCE TITLE, WHILE ADVANCING TO THE NCAA DII PLAYOFFS FOR THE FOURTH-STRAIGHT SEASON. THE BULLDOGS ALSO ADVANCED TO THE QUARTERFINALS, WHICH IS THE FURTHEST IN PROGRAM HISTORY. KYLE SERVED AS AN ASSISTANT COACH AT BOWIE STATE UNIVERSITY IN 2016. DURING THE 2017 SEASON HE SERVED AS AN ASSISTANT COACH FOR BSU'S DEFENSE WHO WAS RANKED #1 IN THE COUNTRY IN PASS EFFICIENCY. IN 2018, JACKSON HELPED LEAD THE PROGRAM TO ITS FIRST 10-WIN SEASON, FIRST CIAA CONFERENCE TITLE AND ITS FIRST NCAA PLAYOFF WIN IN PROGRAM HISTORY.

AFTER FINISHING HIS PLAYING CAREER, KYLE SERVED AS AN ASSISTANT COACH FOR THE BOWIE STATE FOOTBALL TEAM FROM 2011-13. JACKSON SPENT THE 2014 SEASON AS AN ASSISTANT TO THE DIRECTOR OF FOOTBALL OPERATIONS AT GEORGIA STATE UNIVERSITY (FBS) IN ATLANTA, GA. THEN HE SPENT THE 2015 SEASON AT DIVISION II EMPORIA STATE UNIVERSITY AS A DEFENSIVE GRADUATE ASSISTANT COACHING THE DEFENSIVE ENDS.

ENGAGING WITH EXPERTS






