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## HYPOTHESES

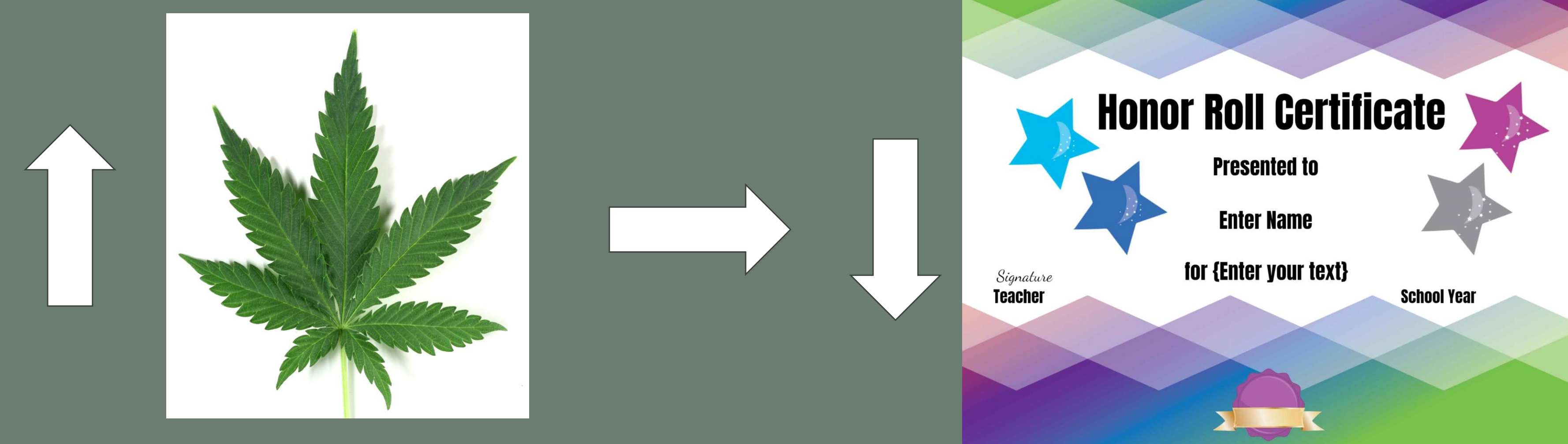
Marijuana use impairs academic success during college.



## RESULTS

Marijuana use impairs academic success during college.

- $r = -.38, p = .008$  significant



## PARTICIPANTS

- ❖ 48 Students
- ❖ 38 Women/9 Men /1 nonbinary
- ❖ Average Age = 22
- ❖ Race
  - ❖ African American (N =44, 91%),
  - ❖ White, (N= 1),
  - ❖ Latino (N =1),
  - ❖ Asian (N =1),
  - ❖ Multiracial (N=1)

## MEASURES

- ❖ Ever been on the dean's list (yes/o)
- ❖ Six-item scale measuring the degree to which one engages in smoking marijuana

## DISCUSSION

The results of this study suggest the following:

- ❖ Students who smoke marijuana more frequently are less likely to report being on the dean's list.
