Only sealed and properly labeled transcripts will be considered official.

Applicants without an undergraduate background in education or psychology must earn a minimum of twelve (12) hours in a foundation program. These credits may be earned at either the undergraduate or graduate level, but are not counted as part of the credits required for the degree. No more than six (6) hours listed in the candidate's approved program for the Master's degree may be taken prior to completion of the twelve (12) basic foundation requirements. Courses may include:
