Scholarship covers:

- ► Tuition & Fees for Spring 2017 semester
- ► Accommodation (shared room (2 twin beds), equipped with full bathroom, kitchen on each floor, washer on odd numbered floors)
- Grades count as resident credits





Students' responsibility:

- Flight = ~\$1500 (can be covered by financial aid)
- Visa = \$160 (can be covered by financial aid)
- ► Food = Previous students said bring anywhere from \$500 \$1000
- ► Health Insurance = \$80
- ► Room Key Deposit = \$8
- ► Incidentals



- Must be enrolled as a full-time student.
- Must have completed a minimum of 30 credits at Bowie State University as an undergraduate or 18 credits as a graduate





Application



Take the following steps to complete your application:

- 1. Fill out and submit the web form by Wednesday, October 19, 2016 for Spring 2017 semester.
- 2. Send the following documents to the program coordinator, Kyle Edwards at kedwards2@bowiestate.edu by Friday, October 28, 2016 to be considered for the Spring 2017 semester:
 - An essay of no more than 1,000 words that explains your expectations for the program and your excitement to study abroad. The essay should address the following questions:
 - Why are you choosing to study abroad?
 - What do you hope to gain from your experience?
 - How will you benefit from this experience in the future?
 - A letter of recommendation from Bowie State University professors or advisors familiar with you and your academic work.
 - Applicants must complete an in-person interview with the program coordinator, Kyle Edwards at kedwards2@bowiestate.edu.






